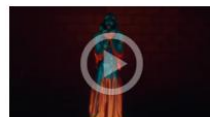

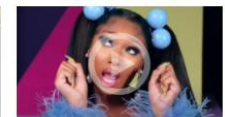

This will take some skill not only in the performance, but also in the editing of the video clips – great videos are made in the editing.
