Spaghetti Towers

It's a Scout favourite, but now's the time to get brothers and sisters – and even grown-ups involved.



All you need is a packet of spaghetti and a packet of marshmallows (or several packets if you're feeling ambitious) and the challenge is to build the tallest tower out of just spaghetti and marshmallows.

Engineering Hint: – triangles are generally more stable than squares or rectangles!
